Dear Parents and Carers

We are very excited to be taking part in the Rudolph Run to support a great cause this Christmas: John Taylor Hospice provide expert 'Taylor-made' end of life care for families in Birmingham and have done so since 1910.

We will be holding our Rudolph Run on Tuesday 1st December (socially distanced) in Brookvale Park at 9.30am. If parents do wish to watch the run, we kindly ask that you socially distance yourselves around the park and do not approach your child's class bubble in order for us to protect children, staff and parents. Nursery children will carry out their Rudolph Run in the playground and any child at home isolating can still join in by running around their garden. All children and staff taking part will be provided with a pair of reindeer antlers, a Rudolph Run sponsorship form and special donation envelopes to collect their sponsorship money in.

Children will have activities and assemblies in school during which they will learn more about the great work carried out by John Taylor Hospice.
